

The Spark: The Mutiny Begins

n February 18, 1946, the mutiny began at the naval base in HMIS Talwar in Bombay (now Mumbai). Initially sparked by demands for better food, pay, and leave, the protest quickly spread to include political demands such as the end of British rule and release of political prisoners. Within days, the

revolt spread to involve around 20,000 sailors across the Indian coastline, including ships stationed at Karachi, Calcutta, and Madras. The mutineers formed action committees, issued leaflets, and declared solidarity with workers' strikes and the wider independence struggle.

#### **Impact and British Response**


